

Summer Camp at Christ Episcopal Church
Position: **Counselor**

The Summer Camp at Christ Episcopal Church in Poughkeepsie is accepting applications for **Counselor** to help lead its nonsectarian and inclusive six-week outdoor summer day camp serving Poughkeepsie elementary children aged 5-10.

Four Counselors are needed to assist the Camp Director and Program Coordinator in achieving the camp goals:

- To create a camp experience for children that is culturally and socially enriching and promotes a sense of caring for self, family, and the larger community.
- To teach children social skills needed to care for themselves, family, and the larger community.
- To promote the camp spirit and group identity among the children they work with.
- To maintain a healthy and safe setting where the children enjoy themselves while developing as confident, creative, and active learners.

Specifically, the counselor will be responsible for:

- * Supervising the children in your group of 12 – 15 children in all activities including those offsite with a Senior Counselor
- * Assisting in planning age-appropriate small group activities and learning.
- * Supporting and contributing to the overall camp program; observing the camp rules
- * Modeling responsible behavior and promoting responsible behavior among campers. The camp uses principles of the **responsive classroom** method for teaching social and behavioral skills.
- * Observe and evaluate the growth of your campers and keep appropriate records.
- * Supporting and assisting the work of specialists who may visit the camp to share their expertise
- * Teaching topics of which you have general knowledge, special knowledge, or interest.
- * Leading your small group in the absence of the Senior Counselor
- * Assisting in daily responsibilities essential to camp safety, routines, and program

All COVID guidance will be followed **if needed** as directed by Director and Program Coordinator.

- *Regular sanitizing surfaces.
- *Make sure all areas (classroom, kitchen, bathroom, and other areas) are cleaned up before leaving for the day)
- * Tables and chairs must be put away neatly at the end of each camp day

QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE COUNSELOR POSITION

- * **Able to teach stem cell activities to children - a priority for 2026**

- * Ability to work collaboratively with others
- * Good Planning and organizational skills
- * High Energy level and good health
- * Enthusiasm for working with children
- * At Least 1 year of college completed: 18 years of age or older
- * Knowledge of topic(s) of special interest that you can teach to children
- * Certifications in Red Cross First Aid and CPR (classes given during orientation week)
- * Must complete online personal safety course Safeguarding online.

The camp is a nonsectarian and inclusive 6-week outdoor day camp located on the grounds of Christ Episcopal Church with outdoor activities occurring daily. Camp runs weekdays from July 6 through August 14 th, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. There will be one staff meeting until 5 pm each week. Counselors must arrive at camp by 8:30 am and stay until 4:30 pm as needed to close the camp day.

Everyone is required to participate in a compensated hours of orientation from Monday, June 29, 30 and July 1 and on Saturday, August 15 for clean up day. (ALL STAFF IS REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE)

The pay is \$16.00. This is a 7-week commitment and applications are due by April 1st, 2025, and must include:

- * your resume
- * 3 references including name and phone number (NO FAMILY or FRIENDS) a teacher, professor, advisor, job, supervisor, or former advisor.
