

## Summer Camp at Christ Church Episcopal Church Position: Senior Counselor

The summer camp at Christ Church Episcopal Church in Poughkeepsie is accepting applications for the Senior Counselor Position to help lead its nonsectarian six-week summer day camp serving Poughkeepsie City elementary children ages 5-10.

Three Senior Counselors are needed to assist the Camp Director and Program Coordinator to achieve the camp goals:

- To create a camp experience for children that is culturally and socially enriching and promotes a sense of caring for self, family, and the larger community.
  - To teach children social skills needed to care for themselves, family, and the larger community.
  - To promote the camp spirit and group identity among the children they work with.
  - To maintain a healthy and safe setting in which the children enjoy themselves while developing as confident, creative, and active learners, including being ever mindful of the Covid 19 protocols.

- Specifically, the Senior Counselor will be responsible for : Providing leadership and supervision for the children in your group of 12-15 children in all activities, with the counselor in your group.
  - Planning the small group activities and learning experiences and maintaining a daily schedule with the support of the Program Coordinator.
  - Supporting and contributing to the overall camp program and observing the camp rules
  - Modeling responsible behavior and promoting responsive behavior among the campers. The camp uses Responsive Classroom Methods for teaching social and behavioral skills.
  - Supporting and assisting the work of specialists who may visit the camp to share their expertise.
  - Teaching topics of which you have general knowledge, special knowledge, and interest.
  - Ensuring all areas are cleaned, all tables and chairs are away at the end of each program day

## **QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE SENIOR COUNSELOR POSITIONS ARE**

- Experience leading and teaching small groups and children
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with others
- Good planning, writing, and organizational skills.
- High energy level, good health, and enthusiasm for being with children.
- Teaching experience is desirable.
- Completed at least 3 years of college and 21 years of age or older.
- Complete Safeguarding Online, as well as Red Cross CPR Pro and Responding to Emergencies Certification which is offered during Staff Orientation week.

The camp is a nonsectarian and inclusive 6-week outdoor day camp located on the grounds of Christ Episcopal Church. Camp runs Monday through Friday, July 7 through August 15th from 9 am to 4 pm for campers. There will be one staff meeting until 5:00 pm each week.

Senior counselors arrive at 8:30 am and stay until 4:30 to close camp.

Everyone will be required to participate in a compensated week of staff orientation from June 30, July 1, 2, 3, and a clean-up day on Saturday, August 16.

Hourly pay is \$17.00 per hour. This is a 7-week commitment
